Fire Action Notice

Evacuation procedures in the event of fire

If a fire alarm sounds:

- Guests should **EVACUATE** the property via one of the ground floor exit doors closing all doors behind you. The rear bedroom has an escapable window opening on to the ground floor roof and the front bedroom window will also open fully but these are not considered as fire escapes.
- Guests should clear the property to a safe distance.
- Call the fire brigade by dialling **999** or **112**. Give the Fire Service the address of the cottage or the what3words reference.
- Guests should only attempt to extinguish a fire ONLY IF SAFE TO DO SO.
- Guests should turn off the LPG from the external isolation point BUT ONLY IF SAFE TO DO SO.
- Notify the owners on 07551 382594 or 07796 938690

If the **Blue Ventilate LED is flashing on the carbon monoxide alarm**, guests should carry out the following actions:

- Open all doors and windows to increase the rate of ventilation.
- Stop using all fuel-burning appliances and turn them off where possible. Turn off the LPG gas at the tanks.
- Evacuate the property. Leave doors and windows open and only re-enter the building when safe to do so.
- Get medical help for anyone suffering the effects of Carbon Monoxide poisoning, such as headache or nausea, advising that Carbon Monoxide inhalation is suspected.
- Contact the property manager who will arrange for the fuel burning appliances to be checked. The appliances should not be used until they have been checked.
